TITLE: Service Worker I – Part-Time Temporary Reserve (PTR)

GRADE: \$12.00/hr.

DEPARTMENT: Parks & Recreation

GENERAL DESCRIPTION: Responsible for care and maintaining of city parks, ballfields, basketball courts, tennis courts, and all other recreational facilities. Required to participate in all City sponsored special events. Accountable to and works under the direction of the Parks and Recreation Director.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:

- A. Maintains city parks, ballfields, basketball courts, tennis court and all other city recreational facilities.
- B. Performs heavy manual labor such as digging, lifting objects or equipment, spraying, painting, and other manual labor.
- C. Operate vehicles and powered equipment, such as mowers, tractors, chain saws, backhoe, electric clippers, sod cutters, and pruning saws.
- D. Mow or edge lawns, using power mowers or edgers.
- E. Care for established lawns by mulching, aerating, weeding, grubbing, removing thatch, or trimming and/or edging around flower beds, walks, or walls.
- F. Maintain or repair tools, equipment, or structures, such as buildings, greenhouses, fences, or benches, using hand or power tools.
- G. Mix and spray or spread fertilizers, herbicides, or insecticides onto grass, shrubs, or trees, using hand or automatic sprayers or spreaders.
- H. Provide proper upkeep of sidewalks, driveways, parking lots, fountains, planters, burial sites, or other grounds features.
- I. Works occasionally on weekends, nights, holidays and special events.
- J. Minor facility maintenance; assemble, install, or repair wiring, electrical or electronic components, pipe systems, plumbing, painting, machinery, or equipment.
- K. Performs other related duties as directed or required by the Parks and Recreation Director.

- * Knowledge of all equipment, tools and supplies required to complete projects.

- ❖ Ability to communicate and follow oral and written instructions
