- A U.S. Veteran Service Organization

PLAQUE REQUIREMENTS:

The plaques may contain any of the details shown on the application form, but **should contain at least the information noted under "Honored Veteran"** (if available). Details listed in the "Optional Information" Section will be included to the fullest extent space allows – you will be contacted before plaque is finalized if "optional" details exceed available space. All plaques will display the official branch seal, unless another type of military symbol/image is desired and a copy submitted with the application.

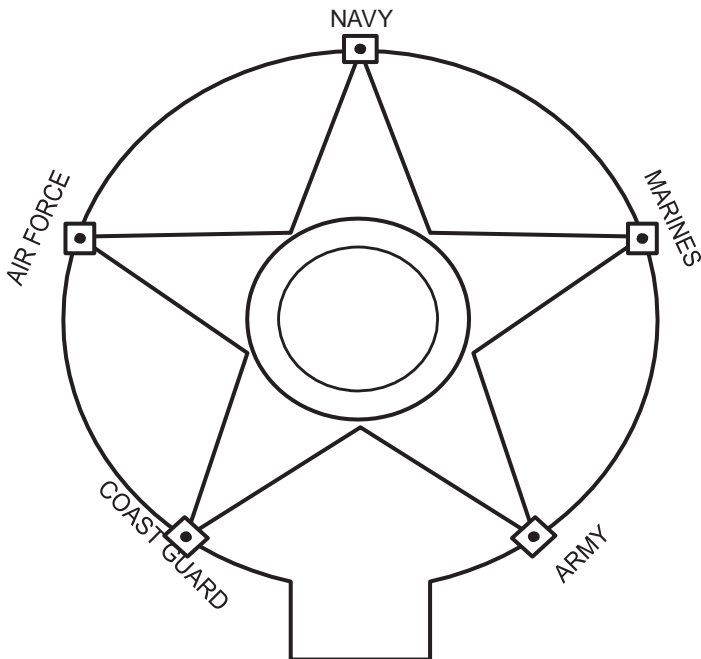
In addition, a photograph and other appropriate military seals or awards may be added as space allows. If you want to include a photograph or digital image, **it must be submitted with the application**. Photographs can be either formal portraits or casual photographs and should be no smaller than 4" X 6" and in good condition. Digital images should be no smaller than 4" X 6" and should have a resolution of at least 300 dpi (dots per inch). See front for examples of layout options with or without photographs. Determine which layout you prefer and circle your choice on the application form. If you would like a "proof copy" sent to you before finalization, please indicate that on the application form and be sure to include all of your contact information (email contact is preferred).

PLAQUE LOCATIONS:

5"x7" PLAQUES

The 5"x7" Plaques will be located around the base of the designated branch flag pole base. When available space on flag pole bases has been exhausted, additional locations will be constructed as required.

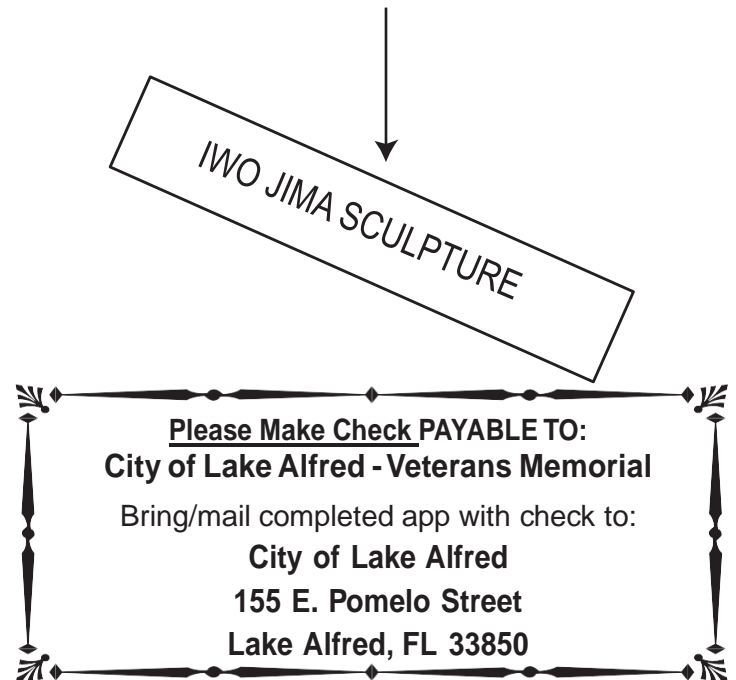
FLAG POLE BASES
