NEW BUSINESS

1.) Vote on Parade Route for the Light Up Lake Alfred Christmas Parade

Parks Director Deal went over the use of the same parade route as we have done in previous years. She explained the route map that was attached has not changed. The lineup will take place at Central Park and will end at Gardner Park, and with this vote that takes place tonight, it will then go to the Commission meeting for further approval, and to the FDOT. Instead of doing just one part of the garden, the City did the whole thing by adding a water fountain, having a butterfly release, and plants that are specific to butterflies and pollinators. 5.) Fall Events Scheduled for 2025
